

MYKE:

HOW MUCH SHOULD I USE?

What is Myke?

Myke is a beneficial soil mychorizae that attaches to the plant and works to build a bigger, more efficient root system helping the plant find more moisture and nutrients in the soil.

Why use it?

Using the recommended amount of Myke when planting extends our current 1 year nursery warranty to 5 years. Warranty will be honored with a store credit of 1/2 the purchase price of the item. Myke must be on the sales receipt with the plant.

The following is a list of the recommended amounts of Myke to use for certain sizes and products:

Trees and Shrubs

- 6-7" Container 1/2 Cup
- 8-10" Container 1 Cup
- 12-15" Container 2 Cups

Bulbs

1 Tbsp per bulb

Houseplants

- 6" Pot 3 Tbsp
- 8" Pot 1/4 Cup
- 12" Pot 1/2 Cup

Annual/Perennial/Vegetable

- Less than 4" Hole 1 Tbsp
- 4" Hole 2 Tbsp
- 8" Hole 1/4 Cup
- 12" Hole 1/2 Cup
