MYKE: HOW MUCH SHOULD | USE?

What is MYKE?

MYKE is an all-natural growth supplement which contain beneficial fungi called mycorrhizae that attaches to the plant and works to build a bigger, more efficient root system helping the plant absorb more moisture and nutrients in the soil. It should not be confused with a fertilizer, this is a supplement.

Why use it?

Using the recommended amount of Myke when planting extends our current 1-year nursery warranty to 5 years. Warranty will be honored with a store credit of ½ the purchase price of the item. Myke must be on the sales receipt with the plant.

The following is a list of the recommended amounts of Myke to use for certain sizes and products:

Trees and Shrubs

6-7 In. Container: ½ Cup 8-10 In. Container: 1 Cup 12-15 In. Container: 2 Cups

Annual/Perennial/Veggies

Less than a 4 In. Hole: 1 Tbsp.

8 In. Hole: ¼ Cup 12 In. Hole: ½ Cup

Exceptions:

The mycorrhizae in MYKE will not colonize the *Ericaceae* plant family (rhododendrons, azaleas, blueberries, cole crops)
